

Course name: Achieving Great Exposures

Level: Beginner

Time : 5 Hours

Prerequisites: None

Equipment required: DSLR Camera such as Rebels, Alphas, Nikon D series, Canon EOS etc. Call if you are not sure. Memory card, camera manual, charged batteries and tripod.

Objectives of class: To develop the participants skills in making obtaining proper exposure to create the image they envision. To prepare participant for future workshops and classes.

Course description: A continuation of the skills developed in the Introduction to DSLR class with a primary emphasis on creating great exposures. Class includes an audio visual lecture and field time to develop skills.

Course content:

- The limits of exposure and why it matters, Why images sometime do not come out why you would like them.
- The components of exposure. The three component of exposure and how they affect you images.
- How to expose properly. Different method for achieving exposure with an emphasis on manual exposure.
- Controlling dynamic range
- Special exposures
